- Basic human subject research: Medical (All Conducting Human Research in the Medical sciences)
- Basic human subject research: Behavioral (All Conducting Human Research in the Behavioral sciences)
- Good Clinical Practice (GCP): If working on Clinical Trial (all)
- Clinical Research Coordinators (CRC): If a clinical coordinator on a clinical trial protocol
- Working with animals: If conducting animal studies
- Working with IACUC: If conducting animal studies
- o **Biohazard and Biosecurity**: If working with hazardous materials
- o **Export control**: If study include international component
- Recruitment: Availability and ability to recruit needed population
